RISK ASSESSMENT COVID -19 and TEST & TRACE

1	All attendees must provide their own face masks, coverings, gloves, and sanitation gel/wipes. Please provide your own zip-lock bags for accumulation of used hygiene materials and dispose of safely.
2	There will be no handling of entry forms, cheques, or cash on the day.
3	The WA Covid Safety Officer (CSO) is Nigel Wroe the WA Field Trial Secretary, or will be as named on the running order for each trial. The CSO will ensure that all Covid prevention measures are maintained during the day and will record any untoward events in a Covid Safety Incident Book. Any individual not following Government Guidelines, or who is deemed to be putting the safety of others at risk will be asked to leave the trial ground.
4	If a competitor or other intended attendee, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must not attend the event and should self-isolate in line with Government advice. You MUST NOT travel or attend if you begin to feel unwell or show signs of symptoms on the morning of this event. (a list of symptoms are as listed below).
5	Attendees MUST NOT attend if from an area in government imposed 'lock down' or they or any member of their household to have suffered any symptoms, tested positive or have been self-isolating of C-19 for 28 DAYS PRIOR to and up to the date of event.
6	Written information on all participants and attendees will be collated to allow NHS Test and Trace to contact all participants if any attendee becomes ill with COVID-19. These records will be kept for 21 days.
7	All communication concerning the trial such as the schedule, the draw, directions, and the running order will be disseminated electronically prior to the trial day and will not be available on the day. Please print off the running order and bring it with you for your own use.
8	Vehicles must be parked with enough spacing between vehicles to enable adequate loading and unloading of dogs and to ensure social distancing guidelines can be adhered to. Do not exercise your dog unless expressly permitted with the permission of the chief steward, and then only with the dog on a lead. Pick up immediately after your dog.
9	Any toilet facilities at the venue MUST BE respected (if available); please use the anti-bacterial spray provided in the wash area. Spray the toilet seat and handle after each use and wash your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds. Facilities during the trial will be 'alfresco'.
10	Previously quarantined bagged prize cards may be available on the day, otherwise these will be sent out following the trial. Hygiene precautions will be observed when presented. Otherwise, certificates may be sent electronically.
11	No food or refreshments will be provided to any competitors. Provisions may be provided to judges, guns, officials, and helpers. If so, these will be provided pre-sealed and from approved retailers.
12	Judges books and current regulations must be provided by the judge concerned and only handled by them. All stationery required by the judges to be provided by themselves.
13	There must be no physical contact with any fellow attendee prior, during or post run. Face masks should be worn during any conferring between the judges.
14	Social distancing to be maintained at all times, especially in the gallery. Please keep a safe distance from any other handlers/judges/guns/officials etc. throughout the event. NO PHYSICAL CONTACT IS ALLOWED , whether with judges, officials, guns, competitors etc.
15	Face coverings may be removed when running a dog but must be replaced when a dog is picked up. Care must be given to replace immediately if speaking to a Judge or Official. When handling game passed from a competitor, a face mask should be worn by the judge, judge's steward and game carrier and should be undertaken at a maximum distance



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	possible. Hands must be sanitised between passing each bird. Gloves could be worn but would need to be changed and safely discarded following each individual run to ensure no cross contamination.
16	All equipment used must be the individual's own wherever possible; game bags, red flags etc. If this is not possible then gloves must be worn and equipment must be thoroughly wiped down with provided antibacterial wipes after use.
17	Shotguns must be handled by the owner only and cartridges must not be transferred between individuals. Guns must only shoot forward to safeguard the gallery, which must be socially distanced.
18	Spectators are not allowed and only the handler of each dog will be permitted on to the trial ground. If a competitor has more than one dog running, an appointed individual from their own household must be willing to hold their additional dog. Other competitors should not be used for this purpose. Anyone else that travelled to the trial with a competitor should be asked to remain in their own vehicle and will not be permitted to spectate but their details will be collected for Test and Trace purposes.
19	No armbands will be issued but the competitor must provide and exhibit their own number prominently and clearly visible when in the line, as listed in the draw. Competitors may use your own armband, and on application to Skinners, they will furnish you with a personal armband and a collection of numbers which you may use. (contact for Skinners: Lynden Lay Email: lynden@skinners.co.uk).
20	Travel around the shoot will normally be on foot, as this allows social distancing to be maintained and reduces the risk of Covid-19 transmission. If practicable, individuals or household groups should travel in separate vehicles.
21	If group transport around the shoot is essential, then social distancing between passengers will be achieved by sitting side by side, not face to face, and with increased ventilation in the vehicle. Face masks must be worn for the duration of the journey by everyone in the vehicle. Hand hygiene before and after each group journey will be required.
22	All intended attendees must have completed the ' TEST AND TRACE ' form at the foot of this Assessment (to be accompanied with entry form if applicable). This to allow NHS Test and Trace to contact all participants if any attendee becomes ill with COVID-19. Failure to return the form prior to event will result in you being turned away.
23	YOU MUST CALL 119 or visit www.nhs.uk AND the organizer immediately if you develop or experience C-19 symptoms as a result following this event (a list of symptoms are attached as below).

-) Competitors must sign, date and return the confirmation section below with their entry form by the closing date specified for the field event to confirm you have read and understood its contents, and that you agree to abide by the requests therein. Other attendees will have been furnished with this Risk Assessment prior to the event and must sign and return this confirmation at least 72 hours before the event.
-) Please remember **YOU** are responsible for your own safety. The Host, the Club, officials or landowner wish to make you aware that they **cannot and will not be held responsible** for any false or misleading information which you provide on this form or for any **THEFT** or **ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE** experienced at this venue and event.
-) Disregarding any of the above will result in you being asked to leave the venue.
