Baby Puppy dog

Two gorgeous babies both look promising, good construction and colour and bone.

- 1st Whiteheads Gunalt Back Chat From Stridview; so nicely put together when he settled, more together on movement
- 2nd Buckleys Brownbank Juniper; loved his head, not as compact as one which is why he is not as together as 1 at this age as you would expect

Minor Puppy dog

- 1st Waltons Akwamar Under My Thumb; nice puppy, a little erratic on the move but presents a nice outline, good in rib and kept his topline on the stand. OK for bone, should develop nicely

Puppy dog

- 1st Sayer & Wallork Braefel BlackThorn; quality puppy, well put together, good front and rib, nice length to height ratio low in hock, moderate all round, moved very well for one so young
- 2nd Bennetts Ansona Chico; heavier in type, good in fore chest, straight front, stood on good legs and feet, he has a tendency to roach on the stand and on the move which spoils his outline
- 3rd Waltons Akwamar Under My Thumb

Junior dog

- 1st Hills Weipowa Double O'Seven JW; my notes say what a stunner, for me a bit plain in head, nice length of neck into well placed shoulders, good front brisket to elbow, well ribbed, stood on good legs and feet, moved well, pushed very hard for the CC. Pleased to award him the RCC
- 2nd Hickmans Theondale First Impression; lovely boy, nice head, kind eye, nice length of neck into well placed shoulders, good construction nothing over exaggerated just needs time to settle into the job in hand and he will come together nicely
- 3rd Connollys Huntly Castaway

Yearling dog

- 1st Carpenters Ashfahl Kepanye; nice head, good construction all through, lovely outline showing plenty of promise, moved well
- 2nd Withers Aladdins Genie; Shorter more compact than 1, clean in neck, nice fore chest plenty of bone

Novice dog

- 1st Martinez Meinweg Autumnal Frost; nice head, kind eye, clean in neck, overall a very nice dog who moved very well. I would however like a little more muscle tone which would improve his outline

Graduate dog

- 1st Suetts Silberliss Peckham Pouncer JW; lots to like about this dog, lovely head, clean neck, well placed shoulders, correct angulation for and aft, nice turn of stifle, low set hocks, stands over plenty of ground, moved well just needs a bit more time for top honours

Postgraduate dog

- 1st Porter-Manning & Porter Wallaroo Kinky Boots JW; upstanding dog giving his handler a hard time, nice head, strong neck of correct length, when settled he moved well
- 2nd Robsons Kalimor Washington At Robricci JW; shorter in back than 1, liked his head, good topline, needs time to mature on, moved ok

Limit dog

- 1st Brown and Filby Desjiem Billy Don't Be A Hero JW; moderate from any angle, nice head with gentle expression, nice fore chest, stood on good legs and feet, moved ok but again I would of liked more muscle on this dog to finish the picture
- 2nd Martins Deifstock Deja Vu For Teufel JW; loved his head, correct neck, brisket to elbow sound, young man that moves well
- 3rd Spavins & Chevalier Ashtern Delphinus

Open dog

- 1st Hawkins Smilek Massachusetts; I did well for this dog last time and he did not disappoint today, nice head, correct ear, slight arch of a strong neck into well placed shoulders, good spring of rib, correct depth of brisket, nice width to thigh, good bone, stood over ground on good legs and feet, fittest dog here today, he moves soundly covering ground as he goes, I could watch him move all day, pleased to award him the DCC and RBIS
- 2nd Kerrs Sh Ch Kalimor Hudson; another favourite of mine, lovely head, correct ear, super construction but today for some reason he couldn't get his act together, moved ok

- 2nd Brierleys Tatze Lunacy; lovely long haired, good lay of shoulder, well ribbed, nice forechest and good bone, moved well
