## **JUDGES CRITERIA 2018-2019**

The Judges Committee of the Weimaraner Association will consider the following criteria together with the depth of knowledge and years of experience within the breed.

### **A1 LIST**

For persons who have previously been approved by The Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed and have completed their first appointment

### **A2 LIST**

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 List and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by The Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 List and have the support of the WA.

### **A3 LIST BREED SPECIALIST** - Minimum requirements (To have owned and exhibited Weimaraners for at least 10 years)

- A) To have a minimum of seven years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the Weimaraner Association.
- B) To have judged a minimum of 150 Weimaraners.
- C) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.
- D) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement.
- E) To have attended a conformation and movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the assessment.
- F) To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and /or assessment where applicable.
- G) To have bred and /or owned a minimum of three dogs of this breed when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book. (Save in exceptional circumstances).
- H) To have stewarded at twelve shows.  
Preferably to have judged the breed at one breed Club Show or FOUR-Supported Entry Shows.

To have judged the breed at a minimum of fifteen Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread.

### **A3 LIST NON BREED SPECIALIST** – Minimum requirements

- A) To have a minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed (to include at least five years in Weimaraners).
  - B) To have judged a minimum of 180 Weimaraners.
  - C) To have awarded Challenge Certificates in at least one other breed.  
To have bred and/or owned a minimum of three dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book. (Save in exceptional circumstances).
- Preferably to have judged this breed at one Breed Club Show or four Supported Entry Shows.  
To have judged Weimaraners at a minimum of ten Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread.

### **B LIST BREED SPECIALIST** - (To have owned and exhibited Weimaraners for at least 5 years)

- A) To have owned and exhibited Weimaraners for at least 5 years and have the support of the WA.
- B) To have judged sixteen Classes of Weimaraners at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs over a period of three Years.
- C) To have judged a minimum of 40 Weimaraners.
- D) To have attended at least one breed specific judging seminar.  
To have stewarded for a minimum of two years and at a minimum of three shows one at least to have been for Weimaraners.

### **B LIST NON BREED SPECIALIST**

- A) To have a minimum of five years judging experience in any one breed. (Other than Weimaraners).
- B) To have judged sixteen classes of Weimaraners at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs over a period of three Years.
- C) To have judged a minimum of forty Weimaraners.  
To have stewarded for a minimum of two years and at a minimum of three shows.

AS FROM 2002 ALL JUDGES ON THE B LISTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ATTEND A BREED SPECIFIC SEMINAR WITHIN THREE YEARS OF THEIR NAME APPEARING ON A B LIST.

CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW GUNDOG GROUP JUDGES MAY BE CONSIDERED EVEN IF THE ABOVE CRITERIA IS NOT MET.

### **C LIST BREED SPECIALIST AND NON BREED SPECIALIST**

For aspirant judges who have shown a genuine interest in the breed.

Inclusion is at the discretion of the committee by a majority vote in favour. Inclusion now does not necessarily ensure inclusion in future years. Lists will be valid for one year at a time. Only the Associations completed questionnaire will be considered.

The breed standard is '*Preferably silver grey, shades of mouse or roe grey permissible; blending to lighter shade on head and ears. Dark eel stripe frequently occurs along back. Whole coat gives an appearance of metallic sheen. Small white mark permissible on chest. White spots resulting from injuries not penalised.*'

Any other coat colour is considered 'colour not recognised by The Kennel Club' and should be considered a serious fault.

Any judge on the Weimaraner Judges List who is found to have placed a blue dog will be removed from the list with immediate effect.

I declare that the information provided is a true and accurate record of my judging experience to date and have read the above statement regarding colour.

It is a condition of being accepted that a critique will be forwarded to the dog press after all judging appointments.
